AN ACT CONCERNING THE PREVENTION OF SUDDEN CARDIAC DEATH IN STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) require all students
- 2 twelve years of age or older to receive an annual electrocardiogram
- 3 screening as a prerequisite to attending school, (2) establish cost-subsidy
- 4 programs in collaboration with health care providers, nonprofit
- 5 organizations and insurers to ensure that such screenings are accessible
- 6 to all families, regardless of financial means, and (3) develop and
- 7 implement education and awareness campaigns to inform students,
- 8 parents and educators about cardiac health and how to identify signs of
- 9 cardiac distress.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent sudden cardiac death and promote awareness of cardiac health in students.
