## AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TAX CREDIT AND AWARDING HOUSING UNIT-EQUIVALENT POINTS FOR THE CONVERSION OF COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL PROPERTIES FOR RESIDENTIAL USE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) establish a tax credit for 2 owners who convert commercial or industrial buildings into residential 3 or mixed-use developments in an amount equivalent to ten per cent of 4 the qualified conversion expenditures; (2) require that ten per cent of the 5 units in such residential or mixed-use development be affordable housing; and (3) award any municipality one-quarter housing unit-6 7 equivalent point for each unrestricted dwelling unit created in such 8 residential or mixed-use development for which the municipality issues 9 a certificate of occupancy.

## Statement of Purpose:

To provide certain tax credits for the conversion of commercial or industrial buildings into residential or mixed-use developments, require that ten per cent of such units be affordable housing and award a municipality one-quarter housing unit-equivalent point for each unrestricted dwelling unit created by such conversion.
