AN ACT CONCERNING THE INSTRUCTION OF AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE IN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to fully fund
- 2 opportunities for the offering of American Sign Language in public
- 3 schools and to require that such offerings are posted in course of study
- 4 handbooks available to students.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide students with opportunities for instruction in American Sign Language in public schools.
