AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPANSION OF THE KATIE BECKETT WAIVER PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That section 17b-283 of the general statutes be amended to add another fifty slots to a waiver program for children with severe, debilitating illnesses or conditions, with two such slots reserved for children with juvenile Tay-Sachs disease or, if there are not two such children, children with another rare, life-threatening disease.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the Katie Beckett waiver program.
