AN ACT INCREASING THE REIMBURSEMENT PERCENTAGE FOR SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECT GRANTS FOR MUNICIPALITIES THAT MEET CERTAIN AFFORDABLE HOUSING THRESHOLDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 10-285a of the general statutes be amended to increase 2 the reimbursement percentage for a school building project grant that a 3 local board of education may be eligible to receive for a five-year period 4 by (1) twenty per cent if the municipality for such board meets or 5 exceeds a ten per cent threshold of affordable housing, as determined 6 under section 8-30g of the general statutes, (2) eight per cent if the 7 municipality for such board meets at least eight per cent but less than 8 ten per cent of such threshold of affordable housing, and (3) five per cent 9 if the municipality for such board meets at least six per cent but less than 10 eight per cent of such threshold of affordable housing.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the reimbursement percentage for school building project grants for municipalities that meet certain affordable housing thresholds to encourage the creation of affordable housing.
