**AN ACT PROHIBITING HEALTH INSURERS FROM USING
SOFTWARE TOOLS TO AUTOMATICALLY DOWNCODE HEALTH
INSURANCE CLAIMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to prohibit any
- 2 health insurer from using a software tool, including, but not limited to,
- 3 artificial intelligence or an algorithm, to automatically downcode or
- 4 deny a health insurance claim submitted by a health care provider
- 5 without detailed review by a clinical peer.

To prohibit any health insurer from using a software tool, including, but not limited to, artificial intelligence or an algorithm, to automatically downcode or deny a health insurance claim submitted by a health care provider without detailed review by a clinical peer.
