**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A DUTY OF GOOD FAITH AND FAIR  
DEALING OWED BY PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to establish a
- 2 pharmacy benefits manager duty of good faith and fair dealing with all
- 3 parties with whom each pharmacy benefits manager interacts in the
- 4 performance of such pharmacy benefits manager's management
- 5 services, including, but not limited to, health carriers, health benefit plan
- 6 sponsors, pharmacies and covered persons.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish a pharmacy benefits manager duty of good faith and fair  
dealing with all parties with whom each pharmacy benefits manager  
interacts in the performance of such pharmacy benefits manager's  
management services, including, but not limited to, health carriers,  
health benefit plan sponsors, pharmacies and covered persons.
