**AN ACT REQUIRING THE HEALTH CARE CABINET TO REPORT ON
THE FEASIBILITY OF REGULATING STOP LOSS INSURANCE
POLICIES USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH HEALTH PLANS AS FULLY
INSURED HEALTH PLANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Health Care
- 2 Cabinet, established pursuant to section 19a-725 of the general statutes,
- 3 to hold invitational hearings and issue a report to the joint standing
- 4 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 5 relating to public health on the feasibility of regulating stop loss
- 6 insurance policies used in conjunction with health plans as fully insured
- 7 health plans.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect patients and policy holders from plans that do not comply
with Affordable Care Act protections.
