AN ACT REQUIRING THE HEALTH CARE CABINET TO REPORT ON THE FEASIBILITY OF REGULATING STOP LOSS INSURANCE POLICIES USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH HEALTH PLANS AS FULLY INSURED HEALTH PLANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to require the Health Care Cabinet, established pursuant to section 19a-725 of the general statutes, to hold invitational hearings and issue a report to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public health on the feasibility of regulating stop loss insurance policies used in conjunction with health plans as fully insured health plans.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect patients and policy holders from plans that do not comply with Affordable Care Act protections.
