**AN ACT CONCERNING OUTPATIENT INFUSION SERVICES
OFFERED BY HOSPITAL-BASED FACILITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit a hospital from
- 2 charging a facility fee for outpatient services utilizing an injection and
- 3 infusion current procedural terminology (CPT) code or a drug
- 4 administration current procedural terminology (CPT) code, and (2)
- 5 require a hospital-affiliated physician to inform a patient that there may
- 6 be a more affordable option for outpatient infusion services than such
- 7 services offered by a hospital-based facility.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect patients from being overcharged for infusion services.
