## AN ACT CONCERNING OUTPATIENT INFUSION SERVICES OFFERED BY HOSPITAL-BASED FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit a hospital from charging a facility fee for outpatient services utilizing an injection and infusion current procedural terminology (CPT) code or a drug administration current procedural terminology (CPT) code, and (2) require a hospital-affiliated physician to inform a patient that there may be a more affordable option for outpatient infusion services than such services offered by a hospital-based facility.

## Statement of Purpose:

To protect patients from being overcharged for infusion services.
