AN ACT ESTABLISHING THAT THE VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION PROHIBITING THE COLLECTION OF A FACILITY FEE BY A HOSPITAL, HEALTH SYSTEM OR HOSPITAL-BASED FACILITY FOR CERTAIN OUTPATIENT HEALTH CARE SERVICES IS AN UNFAIR TRADE PRACTICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (l) of section 19a-508c of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to establish that the violation of any provision of said
- 3 subsection concerning the collection of a facility fee by a hospital, health
- 4 system or hospital-based facility for certain outpatient services is an
- 5 unfair trade practice pursuant to chapter 735a of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect patients by establishing that the violation of any provision concerning the collection of a facility fee by a hospital, health system or hospital-based facility for certain outpatient services is an unfair trade practice.
