## AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF WIRELESS SIGNALS TO SUMMON LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES TO SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require that teachers, school administrators and similar school employees possess a card that can be pressed in order to send a wireless signal to a law enforcement authority to immediately summon such authority to the school where such individuals are located.

## Statement of Purpose:

To prevent school shootings by using wireless signals at schools.
