AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF MAINE'S PFAS-RELATED LEGISLATION AND REGULATIONS AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF SEWAGE SLUDGE IN FARMING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to adopt the state of Maine's
- 2 PFAS prohibition and to establish strict guidelines for the use of sewage
- 3 sludge in farming.

To protect the public health from PFAS and the use of sewage sludge in farming.
