AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN COOKWARE FROM PFAS REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subdivision (10) of subsection (a) of section 22a-903c of the
 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
 thereof (*Effective from passage*):

(10) "Cookware" means durable houseware items used to prepare,
dispense or store food, foodstuffs or beverages, including, but not
limited to, pots, pans, skillets, grills, baking sheets, baking molds, trays,
plates, bowls, cutlery and cooking utensils. <u>"Cookware" does not</u>
include any polymer-coated durable items that the United States Food
and Drug Administration authorizes for food contact.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	from passage	22a-903c(a)(10)

Statement of Purpose:

To exempt certain cookware from the statutory PFAS requirements applicable to consumer goods.
