AN ACT REDEFINING CLASS I ENERGY SOURCES AND ELIMINATING PROGRAMS FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF POWER FROM FUEL CELLS AND OTHER CARBON-EMITTING POWER SOURCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) redefine "Class I 2 renewable energy source" to include any nuclear power generated in the 3 state and exclude any carbon-emitting power generation sources located 4 outside the state, and (2) eliminate any program that derives funding
- 5 from ratepayers in the state for the purpose of procuring power from
- 6 fuel cells or other carbon-emitting power generation sources.

Statement of Purpose:

To (1) redefine "Class I renewable energy source" to include any nuclear power generated in the state and exclude any carbon-emitting generation sources located outside the state, and (2) eliminate any program that derives funding from ratepayers in the state for the purpose of procuring power from fuel cells or other carbon-emitting power generators.
