AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THOMPSON HILL ROAD IN THE TOWN OF COLUMBIA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate 4 one million five hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall 5 be used by the Department of Transportation for the purpose of 6 providing a grant-in-aid to the town of Columbia for improvements to 7 Thompson Hill Road, including, but not limited to, drainage, the bridge 8 and roadbed.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for improvements to Thompson Hill Road in the town of Columbia.
