AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE COMPLETION OF A PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND UNDERPASS IN THE TOWN OF COLUMBIA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate 4 two million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the 5 Department of Energy and Environmental Protection for the purpose of 6 providing a grant-in-aid to the town of Columbia for the completion of 7 the pedestrian bridge over the Hop River and the Flanders Road 8 underpass.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for the completion of the pedestrian bridge over the Hop River and the Flanders Road underpass in the town of Columbia.
