**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE TO IMPROVE THE  
RECREATIONAL FACILITIES AT CAMP OAKDALE IN THE TOWN OF  
MONTVILLE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the  
2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the  
3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate  
4 four million one hundred fifty thousand dollars, the proceeds of which  
5 shall be used by the Department of Economic and Community  
6 Development for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the town of  
7 Montville for improvements to the recreational facilities at Camp  
8 Oakdale, including, but not limited to, paving the parking area, fixing  
9 draining issues in field number seven, installing a splash pad,  
10 upgrading the lighting and paving the outer trail for accessibility for  
11 persons with disabilities.
