AN ACT PROHIBITING COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES INVOLVING FOOD PRODUCTS THAT CONTAIN CERTAIN FOOD ADDITIVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that no person shall 2 manufacture, sell, deliver, distribute, possess or offer for sale in trade or 3 commerce any food product intended for human consumption if such 4 food product contains (1) red dye number two, (2) red dye number four, 5 (3) green dye number one, (4) green dye number two, (5) violet dye 6 number one, (6) butter yellow dye, (7) orange dye number one, (8) 7 orange dye number two, (9) red dye number forty, (10) yellow dye 8 number five, (11) yellow dye number six, (12) blue dye number one, (13) 9 blue dye number two, (14) carmoisine, or (15) erythrosine.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit commercial activities involving food products that contain certain food additives.
