AN ACT CONCERNING EXPANDING ACCESS TO STATE-FUNDED ASSISTED LIVING SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to expand state-funded assisted
- 2 living services to (1) allow more senior citizens who have exhausted
- 3 their resources to age in place, and (2) save state costs on more expensive
- 4 care in skilled nursing facilities.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand access to state-funded assisted living services to allow senior citizens to age in place and save state funds spent on skilled nursing facility care.
