AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE TO FUND AFFORDABLE AND WORKFORCE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That (1) the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate 4 forty million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the 5 Connecticut Housing Finance Authority for the purposes of providing 6 low-interest loans for affordable and workforce housing development, 7 (2) the general statutes be amended to permit a developer to submit a 8 proposal for such a low-interest loan, provided such proposal (A) shall 9 be in a municipality that is below seven per cent compliance with the 10 affordable housing appeals procedure threshold set forth in section 8-11 30g of the general statutes, (B) designates a minimum of ten per cent of 12 all proposed single-family housing as affordable or workforce housing, 13 and (C) is prohibited from including rental property and the maximum 14 loan for a single proposal may not exceed five million dollars, and (3) 15 eligible purchasers may directly access such low-interest loans to 16 purchase a property within a qualifying proposed project.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for affordable and workforce housing development in certain municipalities that have not met the threshold for exemption from the affordable housing appeals procedure.
