AN ACT REQUIRING IN-NETWORK RATES DURING HEALTH INSURANCE CONTRACT DISPUTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require any health 2 insurance contract between a health carrier and a hospital to include 3 provisions providing for continued treatment for covered persons from 4 in-network providers at the in-network rate, including, but not limited 5 to, cost-sharing, during disputes between such health carrier and 6 hospital.
