AN ACT CONCERNING THE BURDEN OF PROOF DURING ADVERSE DETERMINATION AND UTILIZATION REVIEW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 2 rebuttable presumption that health carriers shall bear the burden of
- 3 proving that certain health care services under adverse determination
- 4 or utilization review are not medically necessary.
