AN ACT REGULATING REBATES BY PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require (1) any enrollee's defined cost-sharing for each prescription drug to be calculated at the point of sale based on the net price for such prescription drug, and (2) each pharmacy benefits manager in this state to certify with the Insurance Department that such pharmacy benefits manager complied with the provisions of subdivision (1) of this section.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that (1) pharmacy benefits managers' rebates are calculated at the point of sale based on the net price of the prescription drug, and (2) pharmacy benefits managers certify compliance with the Insurance Department.
