AN ACT REQUIRING CONTRACTS BETWEEN PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGERS AND HEALTH CARRIERS TO PROVIDE FEE-BASED COMPENSATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require that any
- 2 contract between a health carrier and a pharmacy benefits manager
- 3 provide fee-based compensation that shall not be connected to the price
- 4 of the prescription drug, any rebate, premiums or cost-sharing.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that any contract between a health carrier and a pharmacy benefits manager provide fee-based compensation that shall not be connected to the price of the prescription drug, any rebate, premiums or cost-sharing.
