***AN ACT CONCERNING CONSIDERATION OF GEOGRAPHIC
FACTORS WHEN DETERMINING THE LOCATION FOR A PERSON'S
JURY SERVICE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 884 of the general statutes be amended to require that a
- 2 potential juror's geographic proximity to the location of a courthouse be
- 3 a factor in determining where the jury service is to occur, taking into
- 4 consideration that a potential juror's place of residence may be in closer
- 5 geographic proximity to a courthouse located in a different judicial
- 6 district.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that a potential juror's geographic proximity to the location of a courthouse be a factor in determining where the jury service is to occur, taking into consideration that a potential juror's place of residence may be in closer geographic proximity to a courthouse located in a different judicial district.
