**AN ACT CONCERNING LIABILITY FOR AGRICULTURAL
OPERATIONS ENGAGED IN AGRITOURISM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 925 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 a visitor, customer or other invitee of an agricultural operation engaged
- 3 in agritourism shall assume the risk of injury to their person arising out
- 4 of any of the inherent risks of agritourism activities, provided such
- 5 agricultural operation posts a clearly visible sign advising such visitor,
- 6 customer or other invitee that they are assuming such risks.

Statement of Purpose:

To recognize the inherent risks in participating in agritourism activities
and limit the liability of agricultural operators engaged in agritourism
in the state.
