AN ACT IMPOSING FINES AGAINST PERSONS WHO PARTICIPATE IN MARRIAGE FRAUD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 815e of the general statutes be amended to provide that 2 any person who participates in a marriage and any person who is 3 authorized to perform a marriage in this state who participates in or 4 performs a marriage while knowing such marriage is for purposes of 5 evading any provision of United States immigration law shall be fined 6 not less than two thousand dollars and not more than ten thousand 7 dollars per violation.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent knowing and wilful immigration and marriage fraud.
