**AN ACT PROHIBITING DISCRIMINATION IN THE PROVISION OF
HEALTH CARE SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that it shall be a
- 2 discriminatory practice for any health care provider to refuse to provide
- 3 health care services on account of a person's race, color, religious creed,
- 4 sex, gender identity or expression, marital status, age, national origin,
- 5 ancestry, intellectual disability, mental disability, learning disability,
- 6 physical disability, including, but not limited to, blindness, status as a
- 7 veteran or status as a victim of domestic violence.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent discrimination in health care.
