AN ACT PROHIBITING MUNICIPALITIES FROM IMPOSING RESTRICTIONS ON OR TAKING ADVERSE ACTION AGAINST ANY PERSON WHO REPORTS A SUSPECTED FRAUDULENT MARRIAGE TO UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 7 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit 2 municipalities from (1) restricting any individual from reporting a 3 suspected fraudulent marriage to United States Citizenship and 4 Immigration Services, or (2) taking adverse action against any such 5 person for making any such report.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit municipalities from (1) restricting any person from reporting a suspected fraudulent marriage to United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, or (2) taking adverse action against any such person for making any such report.
