***AN ACT FACILITATING STATE LICENSURE OF INTERNATIONAL  
MEDICAL GRADUATES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 370 of the general statutes be amended to facilitate  
2 qualified and experienced foreign medical doctors who lawfully  
3 migrate to the United States in becoming licensed to practice medicine  
4 in the state, including, but not limited to, (1) providing provisional  
5 licenses to international medical graduates who completed residency  
6 outside of the United States and received education and training outside  
7 the United States that is substantially similar to the education and  
8 training that physicians obtain in the United States, (2) providing such  
9 international medical graduates with unrestricted licenses after a two-  
10 year period of supervision by a Connecticut-licensed physician, and (3)  
11 eliminating the requirement that international medical graduates repeat  
12 their residency training or equivalent in an accredited residency  
13 program in the United States.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To address physician shortages by making it easier for qualified and experienced foreign-trained medical doctors who lawfully migrate to the United States to become licensed to practice medicine in Connecticut.
