AN ACT REQUIRING REPORTS ON PEACE OFFICER INTERACTIONS WITH INDIVIDUALS EXPERIENCING AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL CONDITION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapters 104 and 529 of the general statutes be amended to 2 provide that (1) each peace officer who interacts with an individual who 3 is experiencing an emergency medical condition, as defined in section 4 7-294pp of the general statutes, shall prepare a report regarding such 5 contact, (2) each such report shall be provided to the Department of 6 Emergency Services and Public Protection, and (3) said department shall 7 annually compile such reports in an annual report and submit such 8 annual report to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly 9 having cognizance of matters relating to public safety and the judiciary.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase transparency regarding individuals who experience an emergency medical condition while interacting with a peace officer.
