**AN ACT STUDYING THE FEASIBILITY OF INSTALLING PIPES FOR
UTILITY OR FIBER-OPTIC WIRING OR BUILDING A TUNNEL
UNDERNEATH THE LONG ISLAND SOUND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Department of Transportation, in consultation with the
- 2 applicable state agencies of the state of New York, study the feasibility
- 3 of installing pipes for utility or fiber-optic wiring and building a tunnel
- 4 or tunnels for motor vehicle traffic underneath the Long Island Sound
- 5 and report its findings to the joint committee of the General Assembly
- 6 having cognizance of matters relating to transportation.
