AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PROGRAM TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO LANDLORDS TO CREATE AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 8 of the general statutes be amended to establish a program, administered by the Department of Housing, to provide grants to landlords, in an amount not exceeding fifty thousand dollars per dwelling unit, for (1) repairs to vacant properties, (2) additions to existing property, or (3) construction of an accessory dwelling unit on an owner-occupied property, provided each dwelling unit is used for affordable housing for the following five or ten-year period.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a program to provide grants to landlords to create affordable housing.
