AN ACT PERMITTING STATE CLAIMS AGAINST PHARMACEUTICAL COMPANIES FOR DAMAGES CAUSED BY A VACCINATION OR MEDICINAL TREATMENT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 925 of the general statutes be amended to provide that,
- 2 notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, an individual
- 3 may bring a state claim seeking actual and punitive damages from a
- 4 pharmaceutical company for injuries or illnesses caused by the
- 5 administration of a vaccination or medicinal treatment program.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that an individual may bring a state claim seeking actual and punitive damages from a pharmaceutical company for injuries or illnesses caused by the administration of a vaccination or medicinal treatment program.
