AN ACT CONCERNING THE FEES CHARGED FOR A MEDICAL RECORDS POSTMORTEM REPORT AND A TRUE COPY CERTIFICATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 19a of the general statutes be amended to exempt a family
- 2 member of a decedent child from paying the fees for a medical records
- 3 postmortem report of the child from the Office of the Chief Medical
- 4 Examiner and for a true copy certification of such report.
