AN ACT PROHIBITING SCHOLARSHIP DISPLACEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2025) No institution of higher 2 education in the state may reduce the amount of financial aid awarded 3 to any student as a result of such student receiving a scholarship, 4 whether from a private or public source, provided an institution of 5 higher education may reduce the amount of financial aid if (1) a 6 student's total financial aid from all sources meets or exceeds such 7 student's cost of attendance, as defined in 20 USC 1087ll, as amended 8 from time to time, or (2) such reduction is necessary to bring the total 9 financial aid awarded to a student athlete, as defined in section 10a-56 10 of the general statutes, in compliance with the individual or team 11 financial aid restrictions of an athletic association or conference, 12 including, but not limited to, the NCAA, as defined in section 10a-55k 13 of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	July 1, 2025	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit an institution of higher education from reducing the amount of financial aid awarded to a student as a result of such student receiving a scholarship.
