AN ACT CONCERNING LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE PREMIUM RATE INCREASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to protect consumers in this state from the financial burden of long-term care insurance premium rate increases, including, but not limited to, a review of the premium rate adjustment process for long-term care insurance policy premiums.
