AN ACT CONCERNING ROAMING DOGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that any violation of
- 2 a statute concerning a roaming dog be subject to a fine of three hundred
- 3 fifty dollars for a first offense and five hundred fifty dollars for a second
- 4 offense and a misdemeanor penalty for a third or subsequent offense.

Statement of Purpose:

To enhance penalties for unlawfully allowing a dog to roam free.
