***AN ACT CONCERNING JUDICIAL DISCRETION IN SENTENCING FOR
SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, STALKING AND HUMAN
TRAFFICKING.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow courts greater
- 2 discretion when sentencing survivors of domestic violence, stalking and
- 3 human trafficking, recognizing these circumstances as mitigating
- 4 factors.
