AN ACT REQUIRING EXTENDED REAR-FACING CHILD RESTRAINT SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That (1) subsection (d) of section 14-100a of the general statutes be 2 amended to require a person who transports a child under four years of 3 age, instead of two years of age, or weighing less than forty pounds, 4 instead of thirty pounds, to provide and require the child to ride rear-5 facing in a child restraint system equipped with a five-point harness; 6 and (2) the general statutes be amended to require any person who is 7 engaged in the business of selling child restraint systems in the state to 8 include a pamphlet with each child restraint system that details the 9 requirements of state law regarding child restraint systems and the 10 safety benefits of extended rear-facing.

Statement of Purpose:

To require a child under four years of age or weighing less than forty pounds to ride rear-facing in a child restraint system and require a person engaged in the business of selling child restraint systems to include a pamphlet with each such child restraint system detailing the state law and the safety benefits of extended rear-facing.
