AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE OF CERTAIN LIGHTER-THAN-AIR BALLOONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) Not later than October 1, 2 2025, the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection shall 3 engage representatives of the helium industry, including, but not 4 limited to, manufacturers and distributors, to develop a schedule for the 5 phase-out of helium utilized to fill lighter-than-air balloons. Such 6 schedule shall provide for an end to such use in the state not later than 7 December 31, 2027. Not later than February 1, 2026, the commissioner 8 shall submit a report to the joint standing committee of the General 9 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the environment, in 10 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, 11 on the nature of such schedule and progress toward reaching such 12 discontinued use. Such report may contain any additional legislative 13 recommendations concerning such lighter-than-air balloons.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
