**AN ACT CONCERNING STATE-WIDE RECOGNITION OF MINOR
PARTIES FOR PURPOSES OF NOMINATING PETITIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 9-453b of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that, once a minor party candidate for a state-wide office at the last-
- 3 preceding election has received one per cent of the vote for such office,
- 4 a candidate in any municipality or in any district shall be allowed to
- 5 petition onto the ballot under the name of such minor party.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that being recognized as a minor party state-wide shall allow
for recognition of such minor party at more local levels for purposes of
nominating petitions.
