***AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
RESPONSE PROTOCOLS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368d of the general statutes be amended to establish
- 2 certain emergency medical services response protocols, including, but
- 3 not limited to, (1) establishing oxygen administration standards, (2)
- 4 requiring emergency medical services personnel to wear body cameras
- 5 and record patient interactions with such cameras, and (3) requiring
- 6 emergency medical training and certifications to include protocols that
- 7 prioritize patient care over administrative tasks, including, but not
- 8 limited to, insurance verification.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish certain emergency medical services response protocols that promote patient safety and provider transparency and accountability.
