AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CONNECTICUT CONNECT 700 PROGRAM TO EXPAND STATE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to establish the Connecticut 2 Connect 700 program to provide an alternative state government hiring 3 processes for qualified individuals with certain disabilities by providing 4 such persons up to seven hundred hours of on-the-job trial work 5 experience to (1) enable such persons the opportunity to demonstrate their qualifications, (2) promote inclusive hiring practices in state 6 7 government, (3) reduce state government employment turnover, and (4) 8 maximize state workforce diversity and inclusion while fostering the 9 economic self-sufficiency of participants.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish the Connecticut Connect 700 program to expand employment opportunities in state government for individuals with disabilities and to foster workforce inclusiveness.
