AN ACT REQUIRING THE RENEGOTIATION OF CERTAIN AGREEMENTS WITH THE MOHEGAN TRIBE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That (1) the Governor be required to enter into discussions with the 2 Mohegan Tribe concerning amending the agreement between the 3 Mohegan Tribe and the state of Connecticut executed on April 25, 1994, 4 resolving the tribe's land claim against the state, to consider deleting 5 section 1F regarding the agreement of the tribe to make payments in lieu 6 of taxes on certain real property to the town of Montville, and (2) the 7 town of Montville be required to commence discussions with the 8 Mohegan Tribe concerning a revised agreement that recognizes the 9 sovereignty of the Mohegan Tribe.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the renegotiation of an agreement between the Mohegan Tribe and the state concerning the deletion of provisions requiring the tribe to make payments in lieu of taxes on certain real property to the town of Montville and to require the town of Montville to commence discussions with the tribe concerning a revised agreement.
