AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGISTRATION AND MAINTENANCE OF MUNICIPAL INTERNET WEB SITES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) Notwithstanding the 2 provisions of any municipal charter, special act or home rule ordinance, 3 not later than July 1, 2027, each municipality shall (1) register a ".gov" Internet top-level domain for such municipality with the Cybersecurity 4 5 and Infrastructure Security Agency within the United States 6 Department of Homeland Security, and (2) redirect any existing Internet 7 web site addresses maintained by such municipality to such domain or 8 discontinue the use of such addresses. On and after July 1, 2027, each 9 municipality shall maintain an Internet web site with a ".gov" Internet 10 top-level domain. For the purposes of this section, "municipality" has 11 the same meaning as provided in section 7-148 of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
