AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE TO ESTABLISH A CONNECTICUT CIVIL RIGHTS MUSEUM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate three million five hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities to establish a state civil rights museum.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to establish a state civil rights museum.
