AN ACT CONCERNING WATER SAFETY AND SWIM INSTRUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2025) (a) For the purposes of this 2 section, "eligible participant" means any individual under seventeen 3 years of age who (1) resides in a qualified census tract, as defined in 4 section 4-66c of the general statutes, (2) is eligible for the supplemental
- 5 nutrition assistance program administered by the Department of Social
- 6 Services pursuant to the federal Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 and
- 7 section 17b-2 of the general statutes, or (3) is eligible for the federal
- 8 Special Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants and Children
- 9 administered by the Department of Public Health pursuant to section
- 10 19a-59c of the general statutes.
- 11 (b) The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection shall,
- 12 within available appropriations, establish and administer an annual
- 13 program to provide swimming lessons free of charge to eligible
- 14 participants during the summer months. The department may contract
- 15 with one or more nonprofit entities that provide swimming lessons and
- 16 water safety skills instruction to provide swimming lessons under the

- 17 program.
- 18 (c) The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection may
- 19 accept gifts, grants and donations, from any source, public or private,
- 20 for the purpose of establishing and administering such program.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
